**SUBJECT: MARYSVILLE BOULEVARD AND NORTH AVENUE TRAFFIC SIGNAL  
(PN:SG06/SG66) - CONTRACT AWARD AND TRANSFER OF FUNDS  
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$35,000**

**LOCATION/COUNCIL DISTRICT: Marysville Boulevard and North Avenue  
District No. 2**

**SUMMARY**

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION**

It is recommended that the City Council:

1. Approve the transfer of funds in the amount of \$35,000 by adoption of the attached Resolution, and;
2. Accept the low bid of M&M Electric in the amount of \$137,969, and award the contract.

## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The project consists of installing a new traffic signal at the intersection of Marysville Boulevard and North Avenue to provide improved control of vehicular flow through the intersection. The traffic signal will include vehicle detector loops, pedestrian actuated signal indications, and intersection street lighting. Civil improvements include the installation of sidewalk handicapped ramps and reconstruction of a portion of curb, gutter, and sidewalk. The project also includes the installation of interconnect cable to coordinate the proposed traffic signal to adjacent traffic signal systems at the intersections of Raley Boulevard and Bell Avenue, and Marysville Boulevard and Grand Avenue. The installation of the interconnect link between the intersections will complete the North Area Coordination system from Arden Way/Del Paso Boulevard to Raley Boulevard/Bell Avenue.

On April 28, 1992, the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on May 27, 1992. The bids received were:

M&M Electric	\$137,969.00
Richard A. Heaps Electrical Contractor, Inc.	\$152,789.00
Steiny and Company, Inc.	\$175,068.50

The engineer's estimated construction cost was \$138,000. The estimated project completion date is December 31, 1992.

## FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS

Additional funds will be needed to award and complete this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$212,000. The current budget is \$177,000, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program with \$150,000 from Major Streets fund (CIP SG06) and \$27,000 from the Gas Tax fund (CIP SG66). The funds available for this project amount to \$122,451, as of June 8, 1992. It is proposed that the needed additional \$35,000 be transferred to this project from the Miscellaneous Minor Improvements/Traffic Signal Maintenance project (PN:SB46).

## POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.304 of the City Code concerning award of contracts and City Code Chapter 64, Article II, Section 64.208 which governs amendments to the City budget.

**MBE/WBE**




There were 15 planholders for this project, one of which is a certified MBE. Of the three bids received, none was from the certified MBE planholder
