# Resolution

## Recognizing Mary L. Wray

**WHEREAS**, Mary will be retiring at the end of January 2001 after 13 years of dedicated service to the City of Sacramento and to the joint city/county facility of the Sacramento Public Library; and

**WHEREAS**, Mary Wray began her career with the City of Sacramento in 1988, working as the assistant to the Facilities Division manager; and

**WHEREAS**, Mary continued to serve the City as Assistant to the Transportation Division Manager for three years, providing direct support to the Deputy Director of Public Works and accomplishing many major projects including the Mayor's Downtown Transportation Task Force, the 10<sup>th</sup> and I Street parking garage, and the Richards Boulevard Exchange; and

**WHEREAS**, Mary was employed with the Sacramento Housing and Redevelopment Agency (SHRA) from 1991-1997, working as a Program Manager for Downtown Development projects, including construction of the Downtown Plaza, Plaza Park improvements, the relocation of Leywellen Mansion, and the Downtown Streetscape plan; and


**WHEREAS**, she continued her work for SHRA as the Assistant Director of Neighborhood Development, delivering redevelopment services in eight City and County neighborhood redevelopment areas, and in 1996 and 1997, served as the Interim Director of Downtown Development, managing major projects such as Esquire Plaza, the 10<sup>th</sup> and K Street Cineplex, Crest Theater rehabilitation, and the Downtown Hotel projects; and


**WHEREAS**, Mary also served as the Senior Downtown Development Manager for the City of Sacramento, managing the Waterfront Hotel project, Cesar Chavez Plaza improvements, Downtown Parking Study, and the Financial Strategy for Redevelopment 1998-2009; and


**WHEREAS**, Mary left the City of Sacramento to accept the position of Support Services Manager with the joint city/county Sacramento Public Library in September 1998.
