## RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE RENOVATION OF THE MEXICAN-AMERICAN VETERANS MEMORIAL

**WHEREAS**, the Mexican-American Veterans Memorial, in the City of Sacramento and within view of the State Capitol, is dedicated to California Mexican-American veterans that served during World War II; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mexican-American Veterans Memorial Board is comprised of citizens and veterans who have accepted the responsibility for the design, fundraising, construction, and dedication of the beautified and enhanced memorial; and

**WHEREAS**, the beautification and enhancement of the existing Mexican-American Veterans Memorial will meet the following objectives:

- \* *Depict the military history and contribution of American veterans of Mexican decent;*
- \* *Honor California Mexican Americans killed or missing in action;*
- \* *Honor Mexican-American recipients of the Medal of Honor and other recognized heroes;*
- \* *Honor Mexican-Americans called upon to serve during national emergencies; and*
- \* *Honor the Society of Mexican Mothers (Mexican-American War Mothers) who inspired the completion and dedication of the existing memorial in 1951;*

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the Council of the City of Sacramento that we hereby support the beautification and enhancement of the Mexican-American Veterans Memorial that will recognize the sons and daughters from the Mexican-American community, and encourage all Sacramentans to participate in this important endeavor.
