**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION MODIFYING PARKING RESTRICTIONS ON A PORTION OF
V STREET IN THE U.C.D. MEDICAL CENTER RESIDENTIAL PERMIT
PARKING AREA**

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

V Street, north side, from 39th to 42nd Streets. Council District 6.

RECOMMENDATION:

This report recommends that the City Council adopt the attached resolution modifying parking regulations on V Street from 39th to 42nd Streets in the U.C.D. Medical Center residential permit parking area.

SUMMARY:

This report recommends modifying the parking regulations on a portion of V Street from 39th to 42nd Streets (Attachment A). The modified parking restrictions will be in effect twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. Modifying the parking regulations will help to relieve parking congestion generated by U.C.D. Medical Center employees. It is estimated that it will cost \$500 for the installation of regulatory signs.

COMMITTEE/COMMISSION ACTION:

None.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- Parking along the north side of V Street between 39th and 42nd Streets is currently restricted from 8 am to 6 pm seven days a week.
- Residents and their guests are exempt from the parking restriction when the proper permit is displayed.
- Residents petitioned the City to modify the current parking regulations because of increased parking congestion.
- Because the Medical Center is a twenty-four hour facility, night shift employees park along V Street because of its easy access.
- This practice has created parking congestion, noise and litter nuisances for area residents.
- Prohibiting parking twenty-four hours a day will force Medical Center employees to use the off-street that is provided for them.
- A letter outlining the request and a comment return card was distributed to all of the residents that will be impacted by the parking regulation change.
- Only one resident expressed opposition to the proposal.

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The cost to implement the recommended parking regulations is estimated to be \$500 for the installation of the regulatory signs. Funds are available in the On-Street Parking operating budget.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The Planning and Building Department, Environmental Services Division has reviewed the recommendation to modify parking time limits on V Street and has determined that the project is exempt from the provisions of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) under Class 1, Section 15301(c) and Class 11, Section 15311(a) of the CEQA guidelines. Projects exempted under Class 1, Section 15301(c), consist of the operation, repair or minor alterations of existing highways, streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails and similar facilities involving negligible or no expansion of use. Projects exempted under Class 11, Section 15311(a), consist of the construction or replacement of minor structures accessory to existing commercial, industrial or institutional facilities, including but not limited to on-premise signs.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

This recommendation is consistent with the City's Strategic Plan and the goal of the City Council to enhance and preserve the neighborhoods.





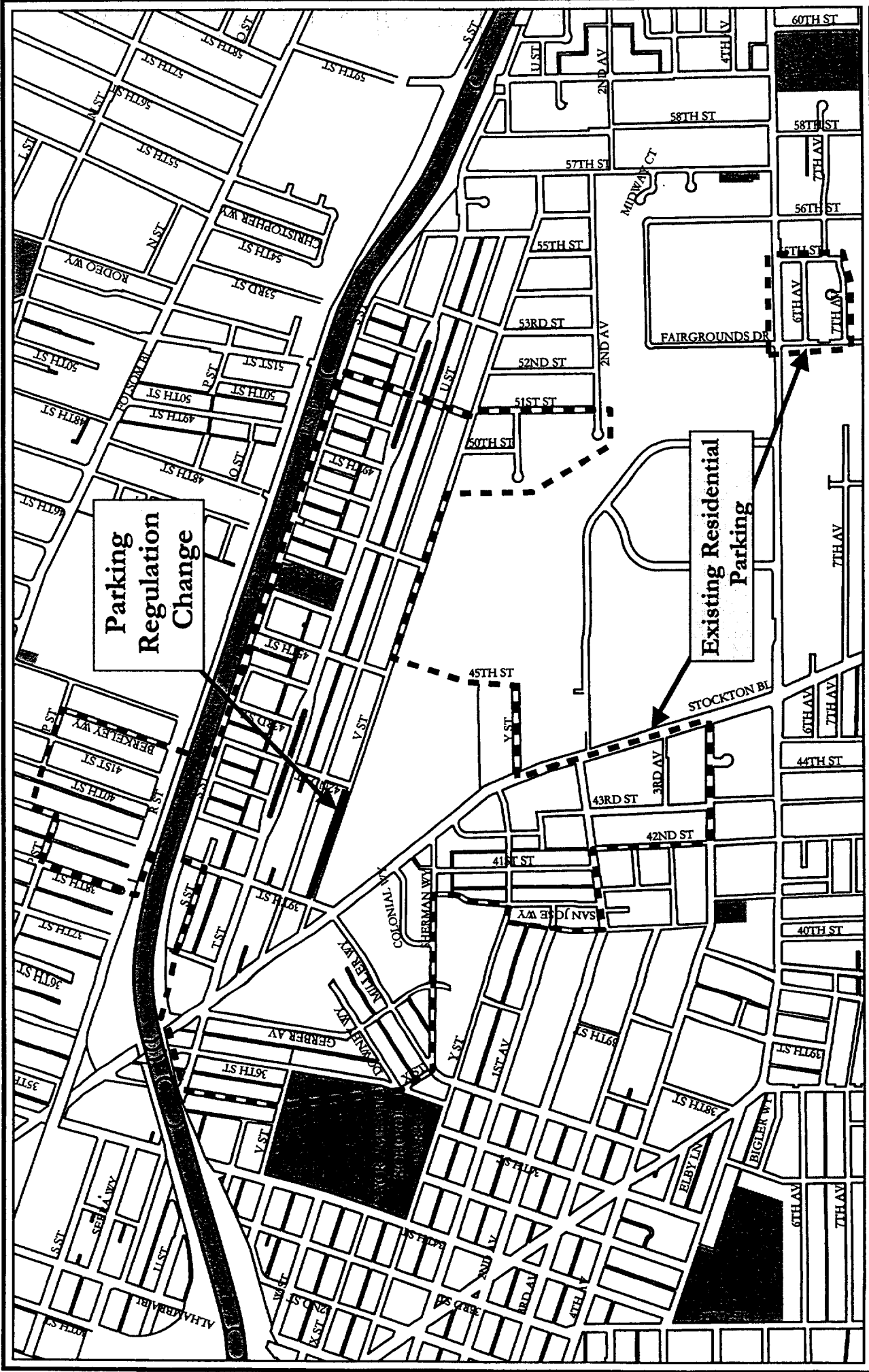
