SUBJECT: Play Equipment at Gardenland Park (C.C. 2286) - Project Approval

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared and copies forwarded to the City Clerk. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

This project will construct playground equipment at Gardenland Park, which is a neighborhood park located at the east end of Bowman Avenue, adjacent to the Natomas East Main Drainage Canal.

FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$65,000 in the Parks and Community Services budget, \$40,000 from Jobs Bill Funds and \$25,000 from CDBG Funds, of which \$64,000 is currently available. The Engineer's estimated construction cost for the project is \$48,300.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on July 9, 1985.
