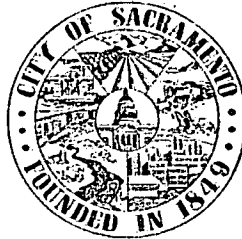

SUBJECT: PROPOSED PARKING TIME LIMITS - V STREET FROM 8TH TO 9TH STREETS

SUMMARY

This report recommends the addition of two (2) hour parking time limits on the south side of V street from 8th to 9th streets.

BACKGROUND

This block of V Street is currently unregulated and is congested with all-day parkers. A request^o has been received from the Sacramento City Unified School District that the on-street parking adjacent to Leland Stanford Junior High School, 810 V Street, be restricted to two (2) hour parking time limits. The school is the sole owner of the property immediately affected. The school district plans to use this facility and is anticipating the need for short-term parking. Two-hour parking regulations would provide short-term parking for conducting business at the school.

FINANCIAL DATA

The cost to implement parking regulations on this street segment is \$200. Funds are available in the Traffic Signs and Markings Operational Budget (101-310-3122-4471).

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This recommendation is consistent with Sacramento City Code 25.109, which regulates parking time limits on streets designated by resolution.

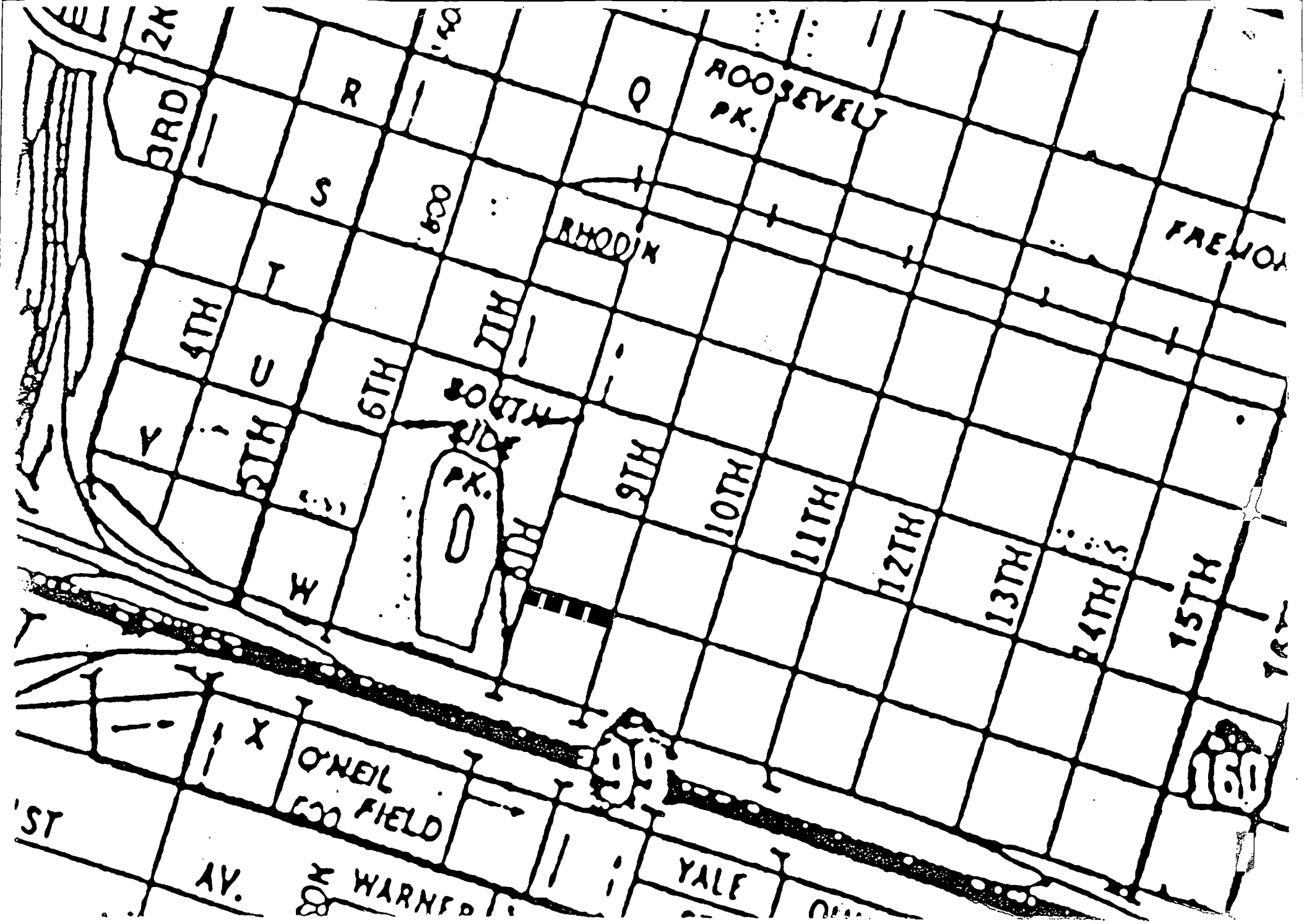

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING PARKING TIME
LIMITS ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF V STREET FROM
8TH TO 9TH STREETS.**

Be it Resolved by the Council of the City of Sacramento:

Pursuant to Section 25.109 of the Sacramento City Code, when authorized signs have been placed by the parking manager giving notice thereof, no person shall stop, stand or park any vehicle in a business district or on street designated by resolutions during the days and hours indicated on such signs for a period of time longer than specified on such signs.
