

ORDINANCE NO. 94-044

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS
4.04.102 AND 4.04.105 OF THE SACRAMENTO
CITY CODE, PERTAINING TO NOISE
STANDARDS FOR AIRCRAFT OPERATIONS
AT SACRAMENTO EXECUTIVE AIRPORT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1.

Section 4.04.102 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.04.102 Prohibited Aircraft Noise Level Defined.

It shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for a person to take off or land an aircraft at the airport if the noise level for the model of aircraft exceeds 84.0 EPNdB as said noise level is set forth in the advisory circular in the columns entitled "Meas EPNdB" or "M/Est EPNdB" as measured at take-off.

SECTION 2.

Section 4.04.105 of the Sacramento City Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

4.04.105 Airport Director Determinations, Noise, Violation.

If the airport director determines, based on the noise data received pursuant to Section 4.04.103 or ascertained by measurement or data obtained pursuant to Section 4.04.104, that the aircraft noise level exceeds a standard at take-off of 84.0 EPNdB, then it shall be unlawful and a misdemeanor for a person to take off or land such an aircraft at the airport. airport director's determination pursuant to Section 4.04.103 or 4.04.104 shall be given in writing to the persons who base a model of the aircraft at the airport which the airport director has determined exceeds a noise level at take-off of 84.0 EPNdB. Such determinations by the airport director shall also be posted in five (5) prominent locations at the airport.
