SUBJECT: ADDITION OF TWO (2) LIMITED TERM POSITIONS FOR PARKING LOT H

**ENERGY CONSERVATION PROJECT** 

### **SUMMARY**

This report requests that the FY 1984-85 approved budget for Facility Maintenance Resource Pool (1931) be amended by the addition of two (2) limited term positions - one (1) Electrician and one (1) Building Maintenance Worker.

# BACKGROUND

The FY 1984-85 approved CIP Budget (CIP No. 84-1900-008) provides funding to replace all fluorescent and incandescent lighting fixtures, except for emergency lighting with energy saving high pressure sodium and modify the electrical system to provide automatic day/night switching. The plans have been completed, the 300 HPS luminaires and lights have been received. The project is ready to begin.

# PROJECT COST ANALYSIS

This project will have an estimated 2.2 years payback based on staff's evaluation, as summarized below:

#### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL:

- 1. That the FY 1984-85 Facility Maintenance Division Resource Pool Budget be amended by the authorization of two (2) limited term positions one (1) Electrician and one (1) Building Maintenance Worker for a period not to exceed 1040 hours per position, to replace all fluorescent and incandescent lighting fixtures, except for emergency lighting, with HPS fixtures and modify the electrical system to provide for automatic day/night switching; and
- 2. That the funding for the two (2) positions will be provided by the FY 1984-85 Parking Lot H Energy Conservation Project (CIP 84-1900-008) 4-12-1936-4378-4630.
