SUBJECT: Resolution Approving Agreement Between the City of

Sacramento and Southern Pacific Transportation Company for Boring Under the Railroad Tracks Immediately East of Power Inn Road for the Fruitridge Road Widening from Power Inn Road to Central California Traction Company, C.C. 2486

SUMMARY:

This agreement will allow the City to bore under the Southern Pacific railroad tracks for the Fruitridge Road widening project. Approval of the agreement is recommended.

BACKGROUND:

The Fruitridge Road widening project will include the installation of traffic signals and interconnection between the intersections for these traffic signals. It will be necessary to bore under the Southern Pacific railroad tracks in order to complete the circuitry. This agreement will allow the City to do the boring required for the road widening project and the traffic signal interconnection.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The cost to the City will be \$225 to partially offset the cost of processing the agreement on the part of the railroad company.


