SUBJECT: Valley Hi Water Transmission Main

### SUMMARY

Proposals to provide Engineering Services for the subject project have been received and reviewed. It is recommended that authorization be granted for an agreement to be executed with the firm of Dewante & Stowell, Consulting Engineers.

### BACKGROUND

During periods of peak demand, water pressure in the Valley Hi area become so low as to be an inconvenience to residents and diminish fire protection capabilities. Hydraulic analysis using the Division's computerized distribution model indicates that a water transmission main will eliminate current pressure problems as well as provide capacity to serve future planned development in the area.

Eleven consulting engineering firms were invited to submit proposals for detailed design of this water transmission main. Ten firms responded with proposals. Five of these firms were selected for interviews with a selection team. The selection team has recommended that Dewante & Stowell, Consulting Engineers, be retained to prepare plans and specifications for a fee not to exceed \$44,950.

### FINANCIAL

This project is part of the 1983-84 Water Distribution Capital Improvement Program (4-13-3153-1541-4820). Current Fund balance is \$699,445.



RECOMMENDATION




