

ORDINANCE NO. 508, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING MARATHON DANCE OR MARATHON WALK; DEFINING THE TERMS USED HEREIN; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 426, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 20, 1929.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. It is hereby declared unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to conduct or carry on any marathon dance or marathon walk in the City of Sacramento.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, a marathon dance or marathon walk shall be construed to mean any dance or exhibition dance or any walkathon or exhibition walk where the contestants or persons participating in said dancing or walking are permitted to either dance or walk either continuously or intermittently for more than eight hours in any calendar day.

SECTION 2. Any person convicted of any violation of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period of not more than six (6) months, or by both fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 426, Fourth Series, passed June 20, 1931, is hereby repealed.
