The discussion on the survey and wage scale of Power Driven Equipment Operators referred back by the City

Council March 22, 1946, was continued to this date. After review and discussion, Mr. Cavanaugh moved that the Board recommend to the City Council that said employees receive the present maximum wage of \$245 per month (including emergency increase) or that they be paid on the basis of the hourly wage for the particular type of equipment operated; seconded by Mr. Deise, thereupon becoming the order of the board.
