SUBJECT: SPECIAL POLICE OFFICER AUTHORIZATION

SUMMARY

This report recommends Special Police Officer powers be granted to the Revenue Inspectors and Claims Collector for the Revenue Division.

BACKGROUND

Beginning with FY 1982/83, the Revenue Division and the Utility Services Division of the Finance Department were combined. The separate yet similar duties of the Revenue Inspectors and the Utility Services Inspectors were merged to increase efficiency and decrease duplicated tasks. Both classes had been granted Special Police Officer status for their separate tasks. The Special Police Officer status permits, when all other means have failed, authorized staff to issue misdemeanor citations to persons found to be in violation of the specific chapters authorized.

DISCUSSION


The four Tax & Compliance Inspectors and the Claims Collector have completed the necessary training and familiarization to begin fully carrying out the combined duties. However, the City Council must grant to each named employee, the Special Police powers for the specific City Code provisions they are authorized to enforce.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution granting Special Police powers to the employees listed for the specific City Code provisions detailed.

SECTION 2.

Those individuals appointed Special Police Officers pursuant to Section One (1) shall have no authority to use firearms in their activity as Special Police Officers and shall have authority to act as Special Police Officers only when on duty, during their regular working hours or when on special assignment at the direction of the Director of Finance or his/her authorized designee.

SECTION 3.

Notwithstanding the appointment of the aforementioned individuals as Special Police Officers, such persons shall not be considered safety personnel for purposes of the Sacramento City Employees' Retirement System.

SECTION 4.

Nothing herein shall be read to limit the power or authority of any duly appointed law enforcement officer of the City to enforce those Chapters of the City Code heretofore set forth.

SECTION 5.

This resolution is enacted pursuant to California Penal Code Sections 830.6, 832 and 832.6.
