SUBJECT: Sacramento Boat Harbor Expansion - Contract 1 (PN:IA21) - Approval of
Change Order 9

SUMMARY

This project is Contract 1 of the expansion of the Sacramento Boat Harbor at Miller Park. The work to be performed consists of excavation of approximately 965,000 yards of dirt from the soccer field area, dredging and relocation of some of the existing berths. Change Order 9 provides for the stabilization in the slopes of the newly excavated boat harbor basin. Approval of Change Order 9 is recommended.

BACKGROUND

J. E. McAmis, Inc. of Chico was awarded the subject project by the City Council on July 22, 1986, under Project No. IA21, Council Contract No. C086005, dated July 21, 1986. Change Order 9 in the amount of \$263,235.00 will provide for slope stabilization in the newly excavated boat harbor basin using filter fabric and rip rap.

FINANCIAL

Change Order 9 in the amount of \$263,235.00 raises the total contract amount from \$2,979,159.02 to \$3,242,394.02. Funds currently budgeted to this project (417-500-IA21-4820) are sufficient to cover Change Order 9.

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
RECOMMENDATION
