Subject: Amendment to the Conservation Element of the 1974

General Plan to Protect Vegetation and Provding for

Installation of Landscaping (M-449)

The 1974 General Plan presently contains very general policies relative to the preservation of vegetation and trees. These policies are presently used to support conditions for tentative map, special permit, and other application requests. The City Attorney's office indicated that the current policies are not specific enough and suggested that additional policies be incorporated into the General Plan in order to support the use of conditions on entititlements.

The purpose of the proposed plan amendment is to clarify existing policies in the General Plan and to set forth specific policies aimed at preserving natural vegetation and trees. The amendment would help support the usage of conditions for tentative maps and other application requests.

# RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends that the Planning Commission recommend approval of the Plan Amendment to the City Council.

# RESOLUTION NO. 80-204

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE 1974 GENERAL PLAN OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO BY AMENDING THE CONSERVATION ELEMENT THEREOF PERTAINING TO VEGETATION

whereas, the City Planning Commission conducted a public hearing on March 13, 1980, concerning the above plan amendments;

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission, after considering the oral and documentary evidence introduced at the hearing, including the environmental determination, has recommended adoption of the above plan amendments by a vote of eight ayes, one absent; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has conducted a public hearing on April 8, 1980, concerning the above plan amendments and has considered the oral and documentary evidence submitted thereon, including the environmental determination;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That the City Council hereby determines to amend the Conservation Element of the 1974 General Plan as set forth in Sections 1 and 2 below:

#### SECTION 1.

That subdivision 5 contained on page 7-3 of the Conservation Element of the 1974 City of Sacramento General Plan hereby is amended to read as follows:

5 - Protect and manage the vegetation and diverse native wildlife of the Region (and City) for the continued use and enjoyment of these resources by man.

### SECTION 2.

That a paragraph entitled "Vegetation" is hereby added to page 7-7 of the Conservation Element of said General Plan to read as follows:

### Vegetation

It is recognized that vegetation, particularly trees, constitute a valuable natural resource to the City which promotes scenic beauty, enhances property values, reduces soil erosion, improves air quality, abates noise and provides shade to reduce energy consumption.

### Vegetation Management Policy.

- l As part of the property development approval process, to provide for the preservation of existing trees where feasible.
- 2 As part of the property development approval process, to provide for the installation of landscaping, including ground cover, trees, and shrubs, and irrigation systems to service the landscaping.
