SUBJECT: DEALER ONLY AND MANUFACTURER REPLACEMENT PARTS PURCHASES

### SUMMARY

Fleet Management has a requirement for the purchase of dealer only and manufacturer replacement parts. This report requests authorization for annual contracts with local dealers and/or manufacturers for these replacement parts.

### BACKGROUND

The Fleet Management Division has a requirement for dealer only or manufacturer replacement parts for City vehicles. Some replacement parts are only available from the manufacturer or from their dealers. Generic replacement parts are not available. Some manufacturers have several dealers in this market area allowing for competitive bidding. Other manufacturers have only one dealer in this area, or Northern California. The purchase of those parts where competitive bidding is not in the City's best interests is desired from the closest dealer or directly from the manufacturer to reduce vehicle downtime and expense. The Support Services Division in conjunction with Fleet Management has contacted the closest vendors which offer the parts or services required. Prices for like dealer only parts were fairly consistent from all vendors surveyed, regardless of location. Exhibit I lists vendors who have demonstrated delivery in a timely manner at a competitive price. The first contracts will be for a fifteen (15) month period, enabling the Support Services Division to issue purchase orders to coincide with the Fiscal Year.


### FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available in the Fleet Management Division's current FY 1985-86 Operating Budget.


RECOMMENDATION

RESOLUTION SUSPENDING FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING FOR THE PURCHASE OF DEALER ONLY AND MANUFACTURER REPLACEMENT PARTS AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE NECESSARY CONTRACTS.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, TWO-THIRDS (2/3) OF ALL MEMBERS VOTING IN FAVOR THEREOF:

That pursuant to Section 57.401 (c) of the Sacramento City Code, it is hereby determined to be in the best interests of the City to suspend formal competitive bidding for the purchase of dealer only and manufacturer replacement parts and that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the necessary contracts through June 30, 1987, with the following vendors in the estimated amounts indicated:
