

## **RESOLUTION 2026-0044**

Adopted by the Sacramento City Council

February 24, 2026

### **Del Rio Trail Sewer Force Main Rehabilitation Project**

#### **BACKGROUND**

- A. In 2021 and 2023, the Sacramento Area Sewer District (SacSewer) retained V&A Consulting Engineers to perform condition assessments on several combined wastewater facilities, including the 72-inch reinforced concrete pipe (RCP) force main (N29) that runs from the City's Sump 2 Facility to the Combined Wastewater Treatment Plant (CWTP).
- B. The assessment revealed severe concrete surface damage and corrosion, and recommended rehabilitation within two to five years to prevent potential catastrophic failure.
- C. The City of Sacramento, in collaboration with SacSewer, is undertaking a project to rehabilitate approximately 5,900 feet of the 72-inch RCP force main, originally constructed in 1960, to restore its structural integrity and extend its useful life by an estimated 50 years.
- D. The Department of Utilities (DOU) intends to utilize the water-cured pressure cured-in-place pipe (CIPP) method to rehabilitate the pipeline with minimal surface disruption.
- E. On September 23, 2025, the City issued Request for Proposals (RFP No. P25141311011) via PlanetBids for Resident Engineer, Inspection, and Material Testing Services. One proposal was received by the October 28, 2025, deadline from MCK America, Inc.
- F. A four-member evaluation panel, including staff from DOU and SacSewer, reviewed the proposal and determined that MCK America, Inc. is qualified to perform the required services.
- G. On October 30, 2025, the City issued a Construction Bid (B25131311013) via Planetbids. Two proposals were received by the December 10, 2025, deadline from SAK Construction LLC and Insituform Technologies LLC. Insituform Technologies LLC was the lowest responsible bidder.
- H. The reimbursement agreement with SacSewer is essential to provide the necessary funding for the City to deliver the project.

**BASED ON THE FACTS SET FORTH IN THE BACKGROUND, THE CITY COUNCIL RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a reimbursement agreement with the Sacramento Area Sewer District in the amount of \$22,392,209 to fund the Del Rio Trail 72-inch Force Main Rehabilitation Project.

**SECTION 2.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to increase the expense budget in the Combined Sewer System Pipe Program (X14170100, Fund 6206) by \$20,792,209.

**SECTION 3.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a professional services agreement with MCK America, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$489,903.24 for Resident Engineer, Inspection, and Material Testing Services for the Del Rio Trail 72-inch Force Main Rehabilitation Project.

**SECTION 4.**

The contract plans and specifications for the Del Rio Trail 72-inch Force Main Rehabilitation Project are approved.

**SECTION 5.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to award the contract to Insituform Technologies LLC.

**SECTION 6.**

The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute the construction agreement with Insituform Technologies LLC in an amount not-to-exceed \$16,966,203.
