SUBJECT: Sac 51 Commuter Bikeway Project (PN:HA41) - Extension of
Contract Bidding Period

SUMMARY

The bidding period for the subject project has been extended for one (1) week, until August 14, 1990, to allow sufficient time for the issuance of an addendum and for the contractors to adjust their bids to include revised specifications for the project.

BACKGROUND

The City Council approved advertising for bids on July 10, 1990, with bid opening on August 7, 1990. Since the approval to advertise was given, design enhancements have been incorporated in the project.

These design enhancements were made a part of the construction contract documents by addendum. Additional time was required to provide sufficient time for contractors to reflect these changes in their bids. Therefore, it was necessary to extend the bidding period from August 7, 1990, to August 14, 1990. Notices were sent on August 3, 1990 by certified mail, informing contractors of the extended bidding period.

The construction cost estimate for the project is \$445,017. Additional costs associated with the proposed design enhancements are estimated at \$14,100. This additional amount will be covered through the project's contingency reserves of \$37,085.

FINANCIAL DATA

The Sac 51 Commuter Bikeway Project's current budget is \$577,500. Remaining contingency reserves after the estimated amount of \$14,100 in design enhancements is deducted, are \$22,985, or 6% of the estimated construction cost. The appropriation of additional funds for this item is not required.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This is consistent with City policy regarding extension of competitive bidding.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the extension of the bid advertising period for this project.
