Subject: DESIGNATION OF FOUR WEEKS OF TIME OFF FROM COUNCIL MEETINGS.

Dear Members in Session:

Summary

At the City Municipal Election on September 22, 1987, the voters approved the Charter Amendment which allows the City Council to designate up to four weeks during which a regular Council meeting need not be held. This report recommends the designation of the weeks for the remainder of 1987 through the year 1990.

Background

The City Charter provides that the City Council shall meet once a week after 5:00 p.m. In order to provide time off from Council meetings, a charter amendment was submitted to the voters on September 22, 1987. The Charter amendment was approved by the voters and the canvas of votes was approved by the City Council on October 6, 1987.

On October 16, 1987 the city Charter amendment was certified by the Secretary of State and recorded with the County Recorder's office. The Charter amendment is now effective.

The attached resolution details the time off dates. Generally, the four weeks to be designated are as follows:

1. The first week of July. (July 4th week)
2. Thanksgiving week
3. Christmas week
4. New Years week

Due to how the calendar falls, the weeks of Labor Day and Veteran's Day may be used to pick up the fourth week.

There is no additional financial impact. Pursuant to City Charter Section 29, the City Council is only compensated for actual meetings attended.


Recommendation
