Dear Mayor Johnson and City Council Members:

We are writing to express our concerns about the discussion and vote at the October 14th Oak Park Redevelopment Advisory Committee (Oak Park RAC) on the proposed development at the intersection of Broadway and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard. (Attached is a one-page background sheet on this project.) In this letter, we outline our concerns and share our recommendations for next steps.

As a result of procedural errors and the meeting structure, the community was not allowed the opportunity to engage in a full discussion of critical, substantive questions, such as:

- Does this project meet the development goals outlined by SHRA and the community?
- Is this project in the best long-term interest of the community?
- How does this project fit in with and impact other development projects?
- How should we best spend the remainder of our redevelopment funds given that we may not be able to bond for many years to come?
- What other projects might be brought before the RAC in the next six months to a year and how might funding for those projects be impacted by a decision on this project?
- If low-income senior housing is needed in our community, is this the best location for those who need this housing the most?
- Are there other SHRA sites (vacant lots) that could be used instead of this location?
- Will the community as a whole benefit from this project and if so, how?

Instead of addressing these questions, the meeting opened with lengthy (more than an hour long) presentations highlighting the qualifications of the developer, architect and their nonprofit partner, All Nations Church. After the truncated public comment, where All Nations parishioners shared their support and community members shared their concerns with the project, the RAC was not given another opportunity to discuss the item before a rushed vote.

We have outlined our concerns below:

1. **Meeting Structure and Time Limits** – The meeting began without any clear time limit for the overall meeting or for the presentations; thus, the presentations by the developer, architect, and All Nations Church dominated the time. The presenters focused on highlighting their professional accomplishments as opposed to sharing information on the impact of the specific project. It was only after a resident raised concerns about the length of the presentations that SHRA cut off the presentation to allow for public comment and shared that the meeting would be extended for 30 minutes. Public comment did not begin on this project until well over an hour into the meeting. RAC members were not allowed to ask all of their questions and many members of the community were not able to share their input or ask their questions.
2. **Conflict of Interest:** A member of the Oak Park RAC who is also affiliated with the church, and the daughter of the Pastor of All Nations Church, continued to sit at the table with other RAC members

throughout the presentations and during the vote. While she did not speak, she did make many non-verbal responses to comments that were made and clapped at various times throughout public comment. Clearly, her presence may have influenced members of the RAC. Although she did not vote on this item, she did not formally recuse herself from the proceedings nor was she asked to leave the room by the chair of the RAC or by SHRA staff.

3. **Violation of RAC Policies and Robert's Rules of Order:** Once public comment was cut off, SHRA staff said that a vote would be taken and asked people to quickly exit the building. Unfortunately, members of the RAC did not have another opportunity to discuss what was raised during the public comment period, nor did the chair formally call the question. This is in violation of RAC policies and is in violation of Roberts Rules of Order.
4. **Incorrect Interpretation of Robert's Rules of Order by SHRA:** One of the RAC members made a motion to "reject staff's recommendation to enter into an ERN with the Related Companies of California." The motion was seconded, but SHRA staff said that the motion was in violation of Roberts Rules of Order because they said motions had to be stated in the "affirmative." We cannot find this "rule" in Roberts Rules of Order.

Because of our serious concerns with the issues outline above, we request that the City Council direct SHRA to:

1. void the RAC vote because of procedural errors;

2. require SHRA staff to work with the Department of Neighborhood Services and Oak Park Neighborhood Association to facilitate community-wide conversations on two distinct issues:

-- a discussion about the need for low-income, senior ONLY housing in Oak Park and the best location for such a project based on the need;

-- a discussion about the best use of the property at MLK Blvd. and Broadway in terms of broad community benefit; and

3. delay requesting the SHRA commission to vote on this proposal until there has been further community-wide discussion on this issue.

We believe that by separating these two issues, the community can engage in meaningful dialogue about what is needed and what the community wants, a dialogue that has yet to occur. The future of our community is too important to be compromised by arbitrary time limits and fundamental procedural errors that should have been addressed by the chair of the RAC and/or by SHRA staff.

History of Redevelopment Efforts at MLK Blvd and Broadway

Historically, the Oak Park community, consistent with the five-year redevelopment plan, has supported mixed-use, mixed-income projects. Several years ago, the Oak Park community worked with another developer to develop a project consistent with these goals for this site, located at the intersection of 2 major streets in the heart of Oak Park.

The developer was not able to move forward with that project and SHRA recently began **working with a new developer for this site, The Related Companies of California**. The developer is proposing a project that includes **90, one-bedroom units for low-income seniors and 5,000 square feet of retail space**. The developer is working in partnership with **All Nations Church**, which is located across the street from the proposed development.

At the **August 12 Oak Park Redevelopment Advisory Committee (Oak Park RAC)**, SHRA staff presented a recommendation to execute an Exclusive Right to Negotiate (ERN) between SHRA and The Related Companies of California. RAC members voted to support the ERN. After the meeting, it became clear that several RAC members did not have a full understanding of the ERN process and of their options to request changes to the project.

At the August 19th SHRA commission meeting, there was a strong show of community support against the proposed ERN with Related Company to build a 90-unit, one bedroom housing project for low-income seniors. **The SHRA commission supported the community's desire to "not support" this project** by rejecting a motion to support the ERN.

After a several members from All Nations Church provided public comment in support of the project at the **September 1 City Council Meeting**, SHRA decided to bring this issue up for second vote at the **October 14 Oak Park RAC meeting**.

A few days before the October 14th meeting, **several Oak Park residents met with Lashelle Dozier, SHRA Executive director**, to express concerns about this project and about this particular meeting. They asked that the meeting be held, but requested the **RAC not vote on this item and instead that there be a fuller discussion of all of the ramifications of this particular project without the pressure of a vote**. Dozier explained that she could not hold up the vote which she explained was a "courtesy" because there had been confusion about this project the first time the Oak Park RAC voted on this proposal.

At the **October 14th Oak Park RAC meeting**, held at the Oak Park Community Center, the room was packed with parishioners from All Nations Church and with Oak Park residents. Residents have several serious concerns about 1.) how the meeting was structured to limit public comment and 2.) several procedural issues. The rushed second vote, which was also in favor of the project, does not accurately reflect the strong, conflicted community feelings on this issue.
