Subject: Recommendation of Bid Award for Construction of Six (6) Lighted

Tennis Courts at Grant Union High School

### SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

### BACKGROUND:

On February 3, 1981, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Construction of Six (6) Lighted Tennis Courts at Grant Union High School and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on February 24, 1981. Bids received are as follows:

#### FINANCIAL DATA:

In FY 1979/80 the City Council approved \$195,000 in the Community Services Department's budget from General funds and State Grant funds for the subject project, of which \$189,719 is currently available. The estimated construction cost was \$145,752.
