

ORDINANCE NO. 838, FOURTH SERIES

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF  
ELECTION SUPPLIES FOR THE REGULAR MUNICIPAL  
ELECTION TO BE HELD ON NOVEMBER 7, 1939,  
WITHOUT FIRST ADVERTISING FOR BIDS, AND MAKING  
THIS ORDINANCE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE  
EFFECT IMMEDIATELY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF

SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. The Purchasing Agent is hereby authorized to purchase all supplies necessary for the conduct of Regular Municipal Election to be held in the City of Sacramento on date of November 7, 1939, without first advertising for bids, such course having been recommended by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure, to take effect immediately, such emergency occasioned in the fact that there may not be sufficient time to advertise for bids and award contracts for said supplies after the last day for the qualification of candidates and holding of said election, and it further appearing that no saving can be effected by advertising therefor.
