Proclamation

Issued by the Mayor

SACRAMENTO NEIGHBORWORKS DAY JUNE 15, 1991

WHEREAS, the affordability of housing in our neighborhoods continues to be of vital concern to the people living, working and doing business in the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento Neighborhood Housing Services and Sacramento Mutual Housing Association are leaders in meeting the challenges of providing and maintaining affordable housing in the City of Sacramento; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento Mutual Housing Association is purchasing the vacant Evergreen Apartments complex to completely rehabilitate as Evergreen Estates, and is planning over 90 new units of affordable multi-family housing in North Sacramento, all of which will be patterned after the successful Glen Ellen Estates project; and

WHEREAS, Sacramento Neighborhood Housing Services, in its fourth year of operation, continues to rehabilitate single family homes, complete in-full development, and conduct community projects such as Operation Clean-Sweep and Paint the Town throughout its targeted neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, these agencies are public/private partnerships and members of the NeighborWorks Week, June 9-15, 1991, these agencies will celebrate the contributions and importance of all neighborhood organizations with ceremonies and festivities at NeighborFair '91 on Saturday, June 15, 1991;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Anne Rudin, Mayor of the City of Sacramento, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 15, 1991 as SACRAMENTO NEIGHBORWORKS DAY, commend these agencies for their work, and call upon all the people of Sacramento to join in the celebration of NeighborFair '91 at Johnston Park.
