SUBJECT: El Camino and Redwood Avenues Alley Sewer Main Replacement (PN:XC61) -  
Contract Completion

#### SUMMARY

The work on the El Camino and Redwood Avenues Alley Sewer Main Replacement project was completed on April 30, 1990 at a cost of \$33,239 and project acceptance is recommended.

#### BACKGROUND

T & S Construction of Sacramento has completed Project No. XC61, Council Contract CO90001, dated March 21, 1990. This project provided for the replacement of the sanitary sewer main in the El Camino and Redwood Avenue alley from Western Avenue to Colfax Street. Additionally, a new sanitary sewer main was placed on Colfax Street from the aforementioned alley to El Camino Avenue.

#### FINANCIAL DATA

As of May 17, 1990 this project had a balance of \$18,506 from the Sewer Fund (414), which is sufficient to close this contract.

#### POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is in conformance with the City of Sacramento's Standard Specifications for Public Works Construction Section 8-4, Final Acceptance and Final Payment of the Work.


Ten bids were received for this project. Two bids were received from minority business enterprises; however, these bids were 16.5% and 31.4% higher than the low bid.

RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended that the City Council:
