5850 Freeport Blvd (background)

- Built in 1960
- Commercial, C-2-EA-4
- One criterion of significance
 - Criterion i
- Brunzell Historical produced evaluation



Criterion i. (Contributions to the broad patterns of the city's history)

5850 Freeport Boulevard (Land Park Bowl)

- Japanese-American developer, Gonzo Sakai built the building which served as a popular venue for the Nisei bowling leagues that met in the building since its construction.
- The building was also identified in the recently completed LGBTQ+ Historic Experience project
- It is the last purpose-built and intact bowling alley from this era in the city of Sacramento
