SUBJECT: Report on Bids for FREEPORT MANOR DRAINAGE PROJECT

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program, has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer recommends that this report be filed pending recommendation of bid award at a later date.

BACKGROUND:

On February 3, 1981, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Freeport Manor Drainage and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on February 24, 1981. The bids received are as follows:

The engineer's estimate for this project was \$474,491.00. Although the low bid is 40.72% below the engineer's estimate, an additional analysis of the bids is necessary before a valid recommendation can be made.
