Subject: Sacramento Boat Harbor Expansion Contract 1 - Change Order 2 (IA21)

SUMMARY

Sacramento Boat Harbor Expansion Contract 1 is currently in progress. Five utility related changes and a decision to delete a bid item from Contract 1 and incorporate in the upcoming Contract 2 has resulted in Contract Change Order 2 in the amount of \$13,009. It is requested Change Order 2 be approved.

BACKGROUND

Contract 1 of the Boat Harbor Expansion Project consists of relocating existing docks, electrical, sewer, water and other incidental utilities to accommodate excavating 960,000 cubic yards of earth for extending harbor facilities. Change Order 2 incorporates changes in the placement of fire hydrants due to field conditions, extending electrical conduit to meet service requirements, and deletes a manhole extension which will be bid under the upcoming Contract 2. The above work has been completed.

This request is being made to Council pursuant to Section 58.602 of the Sacramento City Code which requires Council approval of change orders (supplemental agreements) in excess of \$10,000.

FINANCIAL


The funds currently budgeted to this project are sufficient to cover Change Order 2.

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RECOMMENDATION


It is recommended the City Council authorize the City Manager to execute Change Order 2 in the amount of \$13,099.
