RESOLUTION MEMORIALIZING KATINA HOPE ANTON

IT IS HEREBY NOTED that the families of Terry and Penny Kastanis, Bess Feil Rousseau, Efrosini Giacomaios and Penny Demos suffered a great loss in the passing of Katina Hope Anton on March 2, 1989 at the age of 81 in Sacramento, California; and

WHEREAS, Katina Hope Anton was born on June 6, 1908 on the Aegan coast in the village of Aivali; and

WHEREAS, in 1922, Katina immigrated to this country, and adopting it as her own, made it her home; and

WHEREAS, Katina was the devoted mother of Bess Feil Rousseau and Penny G. Kastanis, and the loving grandmother of Terry and Erick Feil, Kathy Babcock, George Kastanis and Sophia Markoulakis and great grandmother of Sarah, Jason and Alexandria Feil; and

WHEREAS, Mama Anton (as she was fondly called) was a strong woman, known for her wit and aggressiveness, who often stopped people on the street to ask if they were important; and

WHEREAS, Mama Anton loved life so much she continually changed the birthdate on her passport; and

WHEREAS, her homemade cured olives and cinnamon twists were the best her son-in-law Terry has ever tasted; and

WHEREAS, Katina Hope Anton contributed much to her adopted country and instilled in her children and those who knew her, the values and compassion it takes to be a good person, the will to succeed and her love for life; and

WHEREAS, this Council believes it proper that its minutes and the official records of the City recognize the passing of Katina Hope Anton and so, has caused this Resolution to be presented;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED that this Resolution be entered with the minutes of this meeting;
