

ORDINANCE NO. 91-009

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL

ON DATE OF JAN 29 1991

AN ORDINANCE SUSPENDING ISSUANCE OF HORSE-DRAWN VEHICLE OPERATING PERMITS, DRIVER'S PERMITS AND VEHICLE PERMITS AND DECLARING SAID ORDINANCE TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE TO TAKE EFFECT IMMEDIATELY

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1

Notwithstanding any provision of Article XII of Chapter 25 of the Sacramento City Code, the director of the Department of Parks and Community Services shall suspend testing for and issuance of additional horse-drawn vehicle operating permits, horse-drawn vehicle driver's permits and vehicle permits until further action is taken by the City Council.

SECTION 2

This ordinance is an emergency ordinance to take effect immediately. The reason for the emergency is the need for City staff and the City Council to determine what actions should be taken in response to complaints that horses have been worked under inhumane conditions and other complaints about operation of horse-drawn vehicles in Old Sacramento, without allowing the situation to worsen due to the issuance of additional permits.
