

AUGUST 27th, 1921.

The Honorable City Council met in Adjourned Meeting on this date at 11.18 o'clock A. M., Mayor Elkus presiding, and Roll Call being answered by following Members of City Council:

Anderson, Bidwell, Elkus, Funke, Kiernan, Lindley, Wilder.

Absent: Brown, Sullivan.

City Manager Leavey recommended that bid of John M. E. Morrill in sum of \$989.00 be accepted for improvements and alterations in City Hall, in accordance with specifications adopted by City Council.

Councilman Funke moved that recommendation be adopted. Seconded by Councilman Bidwell, and carried by following vote:

City Attorney presented with form approved, Contract between the City of Sacramento, and John M. E. Morrill, for improvements and alterations to City Hall, in accordance with specifications adopted by City Council.

----- Councilman Funke addressed Council, stating that he had been mis-quoted in Evening News-paper, relative to Ordinance prohibiting certain games of chance, and that in his opinion, strict enforcement of Section 319 of the Penal Code would apply to all wheels of fortune.

City Manager Seavey stated that he had been conferring with the City Attorney in the matter and that any illegal games would be stopped in City of Sacramento, but that certain decision rendered by the Appellate Court, had a very strong bearing on the cases mentioned, and at request of Councilman Funke opinion was requested from City Attorney relative to Section 319 of the Penal Code.

Councilman Elkus voted for Messrs. Truesdale, Hopkins and Rainey.

Councilman Funke voted for Messrs. Hicks, Truesdale and Hopkins.

Councilman Kiernan voted for Pickett, Rainey and Hicks.

Councilwoman Lindley voted for Truesdale, Hopkins and Hicks.

Councilman Wilder voted for Truesdale, Hopkins and Hicks.

Absent: Councilmen Brown and Sullivan.

Councilman Funke introduced the following Resolution:
