

ORDINANCE NO. 777, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE GIVING PREFERENCE TO PRINTING
DONE IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; AND PRE-
SCRIBING A CONDITION TO CONSIDERATION AS
TO RESPONSIBLE BIDDER.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1: All printing for which the City
of Sacramento is chargeable, or which is paid for with funds
appropriated wholly or in part by the City of Sacramento,
must be printed within the City of Sacramento, where practicable.

SECTION 2: Printing firms shall be required to
establish consideration as a responsible bidder on City work
as follows:

(a) As a condition to consideration as a responsible
bidder printing concerns must file with the City Manager
and the City Purchasing Agent a sworn statement to the
effect that employees in the employ of the concern which
is to produce such printing are receiving the prevailing
wage rate and are working under conditions prevalent in
the locality in which the work is produced.

(b) When a collective bargaining agreement is in
effect between an employer and employee, who are represented
by a responsible organization which is in no way influenced
or controlled by the management, such agreement as to wages
and hours shall be considered as conditions prevalent in said
locality and shall be the minimum requirements for being
adjudged a responsible bidder under this ordinance.

SECTION 3: Any contract for printing work with a
bidder who is not responsible within the requirements of this
ordinance shall be null and void.
