SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing Execution of Agreement Between Metropolitan Civil Engineering Company and the City of Sacramento for the Preparation of Improvement Plans for Del Paso Heights Street Assessment District No. 6

SUMMARY:

Presented herewith for approval is a consultant services agreement for an amount not to exceed \$ 30,600 between Metropolitan Civil Engineering Company and the City of Sacramento for the preparation of engineering plans for the Del Paso Heights Street Assessment District No. 6 (between Branch Street and Alvarado Boulevard and Nogales Street and Arcade Creek).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

This agreement is presented to conform to the guidelines of the policy for Retention of Professional Consultants for City Projects adopted February 26, 1980. The charges shall represent hourly charges for personnel involved in the work, materials, supplies, stakes, mileage and prints needed in the work process, with the total fee not to exceed \$ 30,600. On October 14, 1980 the City Council approved an agreement for a not to exceed amount of \$ 35,000 for the subject project with Metropolitan Engineering for drafting and right of way computation services. Due to the current in-house workload, it is necessary to expand the scope of the services to include full engineering design.

FINANCIAL DATA:

Funds for the subject project are available from the City Engineer's Operating Budget. These funds will be recovered from Community Development Block Grant revenue upon completion of the project. Construction funds are anticipated in the 1982/83 fiscal year.
