

ORDINANCE NO. 380, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE CURB LINES ON ALHAMBRA BOULEVARD FROM THE SOUTH LINE OF "I" STREET TO THE NORTH LINE OF "N" STREET, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 337, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JULY 14th, 1927.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: The line of the curbs on Alhambra Boulevard, in the City of Sacramento, from the south line of "I" Street to the North line of "N" Street, is hereby changed by removing the west curb line, as established by Ordinance No. 337, Fourth Series, and re-establishing the same three (3) feet easterly of the location established by said Ordinance No. 337, Fourth Series, and removing the east curb line, as established by said ordinance, and re-establishing the same three (3) feet westerly of the location established by said ordinance, thereby narrowing the roadway of said Alhambra six (6) feet, as established by said Ordinance No. 337, Fourth Series.

SECTION 2: Ordinance No. 337, Fourth Series, passed July 14th, 1927, is hereby repealed.
