SUBJECT: Resolution Transferring Funds and Recommendation of Bid Award for
Drainage Improvement Florin Road and 63rd Avenue.

SUMMARY:

The subject project, as part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the Director of Public Works hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On February 21, 1984, the City Council approved plans and specifications for Drainage Improvement Florin Road and 63rd Avenue and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on March 27, 1984. Bids received are as follows:

The Engineer's estimate for the Base Bid is \$76,200.00

Although the low base bid of William Morris Construction Co, in the amount of \$77,638.28 is 1.89% over the engineer's estimate, we feel it is the best bid obtainable, including the amount bid for the base bid plus alternate A.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The City Council has appropriated \$209,500.00 in the Public Works budget from Sewer and Drainage Bond funds for the improvement of Sump 22, of which \$173,179.02 is currently available. Since the subject project will decrease, if not eliminate, the necessity for the improvements to Sump 22, it is proposed that \$100,200.00 be transferred from the Sump 22 project to cover the cost of the subject project.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that \$100,200.00 be transferred from the Sump 22 improvement project by passage of the attached Resolution, and that the low bid of William Morris Construction Co for the base bid plus alternate A in the amount of \$80,536.28 be accepted.
