SUMMARY:

The subject project, as a part of the City's Capital Improvement Program has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On October 12, 1982, the City Council approved plans and specifications for the Gutter Drain Replacement, Downtown and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on November 2, 1982. Bids received are as follows:

The engineer's construction estimate for this project was \$109,489.00. Although the low bid of Forest Land Grading and Paving in the amount of \$119,690.00 is 9.32% over the engineer's estimate, we feel it is the best bid obtainable.

SUMMARY:

The engineer's construction estimate for this project was \$109,489.00. Although the low bid of Forest Land Grading and Paving in the amount of \$119,690.00 is 9.32% over the engineer's estimate, we feel it is the best bid obtainable.

FINANCIAL DATA:

The subject project is not budgeted at the present time. The Budget and Finance Committee approved at their November 16, 1982 meeting staff's recommendation to appropriate sufficient funds from the Sewer Fund. It is therefore proposed that \$142,00.00 be appropriated from the Sewer Fund which contains a sufficient balance to allow such an appropriation.

The City Engineer recommends that:

- 1. \$142,000.00 be appropriated from the Sewer Fund by passage of the attached Resolution, and
- 2. The low bid of Forest Land Grading and Paving in the/amount of \$119,690.00 be accepted.
