**SUBJECT: Sump 40 (Sewer) Reconstruction (CC:9549) - Contract Award**

SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

BACKGROUND

On May 8, 1986 the City Council approved the plans and specifications for this project. Bids were received and opened by the City Clerk on June 3, 1986. The bids received were:

Dannan Construction Company	\$57,335
CSV Sprinklers, Inc.	\$62,013

The estimated project completion date is October 1, 1986. The engineer's estimated contract cost was \$47,000. Even though the low bid of Dannan Construction Company was 22% above the engineer's estimated cost, it is believed the best bid available at this time.

FINANCIAL


Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$83,500. The current budget for the Sewer Lift Station Renovation is \$200,000, of which \$138,000 is available for this project. This budget was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from Sewer Funds.

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RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council accept the low bid of Dannan Construction Company in the amount of \$57,335 and award the contract.


