## RESOLUTION NO. 5152

ADOPTED BY THE SACRAMENTO CITY COUNCIL ON DATE OF DECEMBER 23RD, 1980

VACATING PUBLIC EASEMENT PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 50430 TO 50445, INCLUSIVE, OF THE GOVERNMENT CODE OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the City Council of the City of Sacramento requesting vacation of a portion of the public alley hereinafter described by vacating the Alley in the Block bounded by 4th and 5th Avenues and 35th and 36th Streets.

WHEREAS, this Council did fix the 23rd day of December, 1980, at the hour of 7:30 o'clock P. M. of said day, in the Council Chambers of the City Council of the City of Sacramento in the City Hall on I Street between 9th and 10th Streets of said City, as the time and place for hearing said petition and did give due notice thereof as required pursuant to the Street Vacation Act of 1941 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the said City Council has adopted a Resolution of Intention to vacate that portion of the alley hereinafter described pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 5152, adopted by the City Council on December 2nd, 1980; and

WHEREAS, said City Council did hear the evidence offered by any and all parties interested in said petition; and

WHEREAS, said vacation is declared after due proceedings had therefor according to law and the finding by the City Council which is hereby made, that said Alley is unnecessary for present or prospective use.

OFFICE OF THE CITY CLERK NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

That this Council has heretofore adopted it's Engineer's Report and the same is attached hereto and marked Exhibit "A" and incorporated by reference herein.

That the hereinafter described public easement in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, be, and the same is hereby ordered vacated:

All that certain real property situate in the City of Sacramento, County of Sacramento, State of California, and being a portion of Block 55, Subdivision E, Oak Park shown on the plat filed in Book A of Maps at Page 31, Sacramento County Records; said real property being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the Northerly right of way line of 5th Avenue (formerly Park Avenue) with the Easterly right of way line of the 20 foot Alley as shown on said plat; thence along said Easterly right of way line North 16° 29' 15" East 369.88 feet to the Northwesterly corner of Lot 17 as shown on said plat; thence leaving last said line North 73° 27' 49" West 20.00 feet to the Northeasterly corner of Lot 7 as shown on said plat; thence along the Westerly right of way line of said 20.00 foot alley, South 16° 29' 15" West 369.89 feet to the point of intersection of last said line with the Northerly right of way line of 5th Avenue as shown on Sacramento Electric, Gas and Railway Company, Oak Park Survey Plat filed in Book 5 of Maps, at Page 16, Sacramento County Records; thence along last said line South 73° 28' 46" East 20.00 feet to the point of beginning and containing 0.17 acre, more or less.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a copy of this order, attested by the Clerk of this Council, be recorded in the office of the Recorder of the County of Sacramento.
