SUBJECT: Approval of Plans and Specifications for Florin Road, 29th Street to Franklin Boulevard and Traffic Signal Interconnect on Florin Road from South Land Park Drive to Franklin Boulevard

SUMMARY:

The Director of Public Works office has prepared plans and specifications for the subject project. Copy of said plans and specifications has been forwarded to the City Clerk and approval is recommended.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The subject project includes median island geometric improvements on Florin Road between 29th Street and Franklin Boulevard and a traffic signal interconnect system between Amherst Street and Franklin Boulevard. The proposed improvements will provide for more efficient and safe traffic flow on this main arterial street. After completion, left turns will be allowed into Munson Way but not out of Munson Way as a safety measure. Left turns out of northbound Luther Drive will be improved slightly and a new left turn pocket will be provided for the Southgate Mobil Home Park.

FINANCIAL:

The City Council approved \$250,000.00 in the Public Works Budget from the Major Street Construction Fund for the subject project. The total amount currently available for this project is \$238,335.32. The current estimated construction cost is \$205,709.50.
