Subject: Recommendation of Bid Award for Demolition of the Existing Building
Located at 1229 "I" Street

SUMMARY:

This demolition project is part of the Fire Station No. 2 project and its funding. The demolition is necessary to clear the site for the proposed construction of the fire station. Bids have been received and the City Engineer hereby recommends bid award.

BACKGROUND:

On February 12, 1980 the City Council approved plans and specifications for the subject project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on March 4, 1980. Bids received are as follows:

FINANCIAL DATA:

In F.Y. 1978/79 the City Council approved in the Engineering Department's Budget, \$1,025,000.00 of General Funds for the Fire Station No. 2 project. The amount currently available is \$690,000.00. The estimated construction cost for this portion of the project is \$18,000.00.

The City Engineer recommends that the low bid of West Coast Building Wrecking, Inc. in the amount of \$14,300.00 be accepted.

NOTE THE FOLLOWING:

An existing underground gasoline fuel tank shall be removed or filled in according to City Fire Department regulations. No portion of the tank may remain within 4' of the finished site grade. The Contractor shall obtain a tank removal permit from the City Fire Prevention Division prior to any work being done on the tank.

Payment for removal of the tank shall be considered as included in the lump sum price bid.


