SUBJECT: Purchase of Mobile Data Computers (MDCs)

LOCATION AND COUNCIL DISTRICT:

City-wide.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the City Council adopt the attached resolution authorizing the purchase of sixteen (16) Mobile Data Computers (MDCs) and the associated in-car mounting equipment from Compaq Computer Corporation in the amount of \$134,012.

SUMMARY:

The Police Department has a need to purchase an additional sixteen (16) Mobile Data Computers (MDCs) and the associated in-car mounting equipment at a cost of \$134,012. Approval is requested to suspend formal competitive bidding and purchase the additional equipment from Compac Computer Corporation.

The mission of the Sacramento Police Department is to work in partnership with the Community to protect life and property; solve neighborhood problems, and enhance the quality of life in our City.

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BACKGROUND:

On April 19, 2001, City Council approved Resolution No. 2001-220 reaffirming Resolution No. 96-632 suspending formal competitive bidding for the establishment of contracts for supplies and services necessary for the implementation of the Automated Information Systems Project. Resolution No. 2001-220 further authorized the purchase of 210 Litton MDCs and the associated in-car mounting equipment from Compaq Computer Corporation.

The approval of additional authorized patrol positions and the required patrol vehicles funded through grants and other sources has resulted in the need to obtain sixteen (16) additional MDCs and the associated in-car mounting equipment from Compaq Computer Corporation..

FINANCIAL CONSIDERATIONS:

The purchase price for 16 Litton MDCs and associated in-car mounting equipment and sales tax is \$134,012. Fifteen (15) of the MDCs will be funded by the 1999 Local Law Enforcement Block Grant and one (1) MDC will be funded by the Natomas School District Agreement. There are sufficient funds in each of these programs to cover the purchase price.

ENVIRONMENTAL CONSIDERATIONS:

This proposal does not constitute a "project" and is therefore exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act according to CEQA guidelines Section 15061(b)(1) and 15378(b)(3).

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS:

None.

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ESBD/SBE EFFORTS:



**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO
PURCHASE LITTON MOBILE DATA COMPUTERS
FROM COMPAQ COMPUTER CORPORATION
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$134,012**

WHEREAS the Police Department was awarded a COPS More grant for the implementation of a new Police Automated Information System, which includes the replacement of the MDTs and

WHEREAS Council adopted Resolution No. 96-632, suspending formal competitive bidding for the establishment of contracts for supplies and services necessary for the implementation of the Automated Information System Project and

WHEREAS Council adopted Resolution No. 2001-220 reaffirming Resolution No. 96-632 and authorizing the City Manager to purchase 210 MDCs and the associated in-car mounting equipment from Compaq Computer Corporation.
