

ORDINANCE NO. 512, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 267, /PASSED FEBRUARY 11, 1926, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE CHARGES FOR WORK PERFORMED BY THE CITY ENGINEER UPON STREETS, AVENUES, LANES, ALLEYS, COURTS, PLACES AND SIDEWALKS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF SEWERS AND FOR ALL OTHER WORK DONE BY HIM, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 113, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED MARCH 1, 1923."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 267, Fourth Series, passed February 11, 1926, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 1. The charges for the services of the City Engineer on all work performed by him, or under his direction, under the provisions of the General Laws of the State of California affecting the improvement of streets, avenues, lanes, alleys, courts, places and other public work are hereby fixed as follows: Ten per cent (10%) of the contract price where the contract price is less than \$5,000.00; eight per cent (8%) of the contract price where the contract price is from \$5,000.00 to \$10,000.00; six and one-half per cent (6½%) of the contract price when the contract price is over \$10,000.00 and less than \$25,000.00; six per cent (6%) of the contract price when the contract price is from \$25,000.00 to \$50,000.00; five and one-half per cent (5½%) of the contract price when the contract price is \$50,000.00 or over. This fee will cover the cost of the preparation of all proceedings, all field work, all office and clerical work in connection therewith, and all inspection.
