SUBJECT: Resolution Authorizing the Transfer of Funds From the

Administrative Contingency to the City Engineer's Budget

for Engineering and Architectural Services

## SUMMARY:

The City Engineer's Budget for fiscal year 1980/81 contains \$805,355 for consulting engineering and architectural fees. With the Council approval of February 3, 1981 for the Pocket Road Storm and Sanitary Sewer A/D #2 and subdivision projects, which are pending or anticipated, an additional \$350,000 is required for service fees.

#### BACKGROUND:

The consulting engineering and architectural line in the City Engineer's Budget is not related to the normal City's Capital Improvement Budget, which contains engineering or architectural allowances in each project. The expenditures in the engineering and architectural line are directly related to private assessment districts and subdivision activities throughout the City. The City collects money from either the subdivider in case of a cash subdivision, or from the assessment district in case of an assessment district and these funds become revenue to the City's General Fund. The City's expenditures for consulting engineering work for plan preparation are therefore offset by payments from the subdivider or from the assessment district.

As of January 30, 1981, expenditures and collections for engineering and architectural service fees are as follows:

Due to projects that are pending or anticipated and the approval of the Pocket Road Storm and Sanitary Sewer A/D #2 project, it is requested that a total of \$350,000 be allocated.

# FINANCIAL:

As stated above, the City collects funds from the developer or the assessment district to pay for the engineering or subdivision; therefore, additional expenditures recommended in this report will be completely offset by additional revenue into the General Fund.

# RECOMMENDATION:

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve the transfer of \$350,000 from the Administrative Contingency Budget to the City Engineer's Budget and direct staff to forward the attached resolution to Council for adoption.

RESOLUTION AMENDING THE CITY BUDGET FOR FY 1980/81 FOR ENGINEERING AND ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES

#### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

- That additional money is required to pay fees for projects that are pending or anticipated.
- 2. The City Budget for Fiscal Year 1980/81 is hereby amended by the transfer of \$350,000 from the Administrative Contingency to the City Engineer's Budget (1-01-2600-0000-4252) for Engineering and Architectural services for the purpose stated in Paragraph 1 above.
- 3. The above transfer is to be supported by revenues forthcoming from either the subdivider in case of a cash subdivision or from the assessment district in case of an assessment district subdivision. These revenues will be deposited in the General Fund.
