SUBJECT: Cancellation of Bid No. 1088 and Purchase of an ISCO Flow
Monitoring System

SUMMARY

The Flood Control and Sewer Division is requesting the authorization to purchase an ISCO Series 2500 Flow Monitoring System for a total cost of \$35,820.00.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On May 5, 1987, formal bids were solicited for this flow control system under Bid No. 1088. No bids were received at the May 26, 1987 opening, not even one from ISCO, citing the holiday as the reason for the mail delay.

From initial request, no other source of supply was known that could meet the exacting specifications of the ISCO unit currently being used by the County of Sacramento. Because of uncertainty, however, it was felt that advertising for bids and "testing the market" would be in the best interest of the City. The bid response, or lack thereof, appears to confirm initial suspicions that there is no other source.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available in the Flood Control and Sewer Division FY 86/87 Budget to cover this expenditure.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that pursuant to Sections 57.307 and 57.401 of the City Code that Council cancel Bid No. 1088, suspend formal bidding and authorize the issuance of a contract to ISCO in the amount of \$35,820.00.

RESOLUTION SUSPENDING FORMAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING
FOR THE PURCHASE OF AN ISCO FLOW MONITORING
SYSTEM FOR THE FLOOD CONTROL AND SEWER DIVISION
