



Dear Mr. Peachey:

This letter is intended to respond to your question regarding the possible effects of constructing a 6-foot masonry wall at your property line at parcel #215-0230-063 in Rio Linda. The purpose of the wall is to separate your M-1 use from an adjacent residential property where the house would be approximately 50 feet from the wall. The noise source in question is engine run-up testing at McClellan AFB, about 1 mile away on the residence side of the wall.

The presence of the wall as described above would be expected to result in reflection of sound back towards the house. Theoretically, up to a 3 decibel increase in sound pressure levels could be achieved, which would be considered a noticeable change by most people. Given the wall height of 6 feet and the distance to the house from the wall, it is likely that the increase in noise level would be somewhat less than 3 decibels, but it is not possible to precisely predict the amount of reflected sound in a free-field situation such as you have described. In any case, it should be noted by all concerned parties that the presence of the proposed masonry wall would be expected to create some reflection of sound from McClellan AFB engine testing which would be likely to be noticeable to the resident.

I hope that this information will be useful to you and the City of Sacramento in consideration of your proposed building permit application. If you have any questions, please call me in Fair Oaks at 961-5822.

This item has 3 points 1. permit for a Vehicle Shop (granted 12-4-86 by "planning"), 2. Variance ~~to~~ To waive 6 foot masonry wall, & 3. Dog Kennel Permit.

Background 1220 Ascot is zoned industrial. I bought the property with the intention of locating my dump Truck business, shop & dogs there. "Planning" was called by me & the agent & said our intentions were consistent with the zoning. After buying the property I had it surveyed (attached) & found my neighbors fence encroaching 13 feet onto my land. Mr Zoyal, the neighbor, said he'd be sorry if I moved the fence but I moved it anyway. Since then he has opposed all my plans.

1. The Dump Truck Shop is consistent with industrial zoning & has been approved by "Planning" with conditions.
2. The Variance to Waive the masonry wall should be granted. The wall's purpose according to staff is a noise & visual buffer. The City & County last week restricted new housing in my area because of our neighbor McClellan AFB sound levels. My land is in the flight path of the base & often exceeds 65 decibels of sound. A masonry wall will not stop the sound already in the area, as a visual buffer I have already installed a chain link fence with Redwood slats. I would gladly work with staff on additional visual barriers.

As a small businessman I am trying to make ends meet. A soundwall on just 1 side of my property will cost over 10 thousand dollars, (37th a linear foot x 290 feet). We run the business ourselves with no employees & would be hard put to pay for a wall this expensive. We are willing to meet with staff & explore alternatives to a wall, such as landscaping & placement of the shop.

3. The Dog Kennel license - I have 10 Dobermans the dogs guard my property, equipment, & home. A number of neighbors have signed letters supporting the

dogs. They are not allowed to roam free & are

made my property at all times. My area

has a high crime rate - my neighbor at 1210 court

has had his property stolen on more than 1 occasion

& my dogs have already helped prevent one theft.

Earlier this year a stolen pink Panther that a

woman & her daughter were murdered for was found

along with the Curricula across the street from

my property. I cannot afford the loss of any

of my equipment.

I do not understand the sanitation issue

that dog raised. The abut on city water so

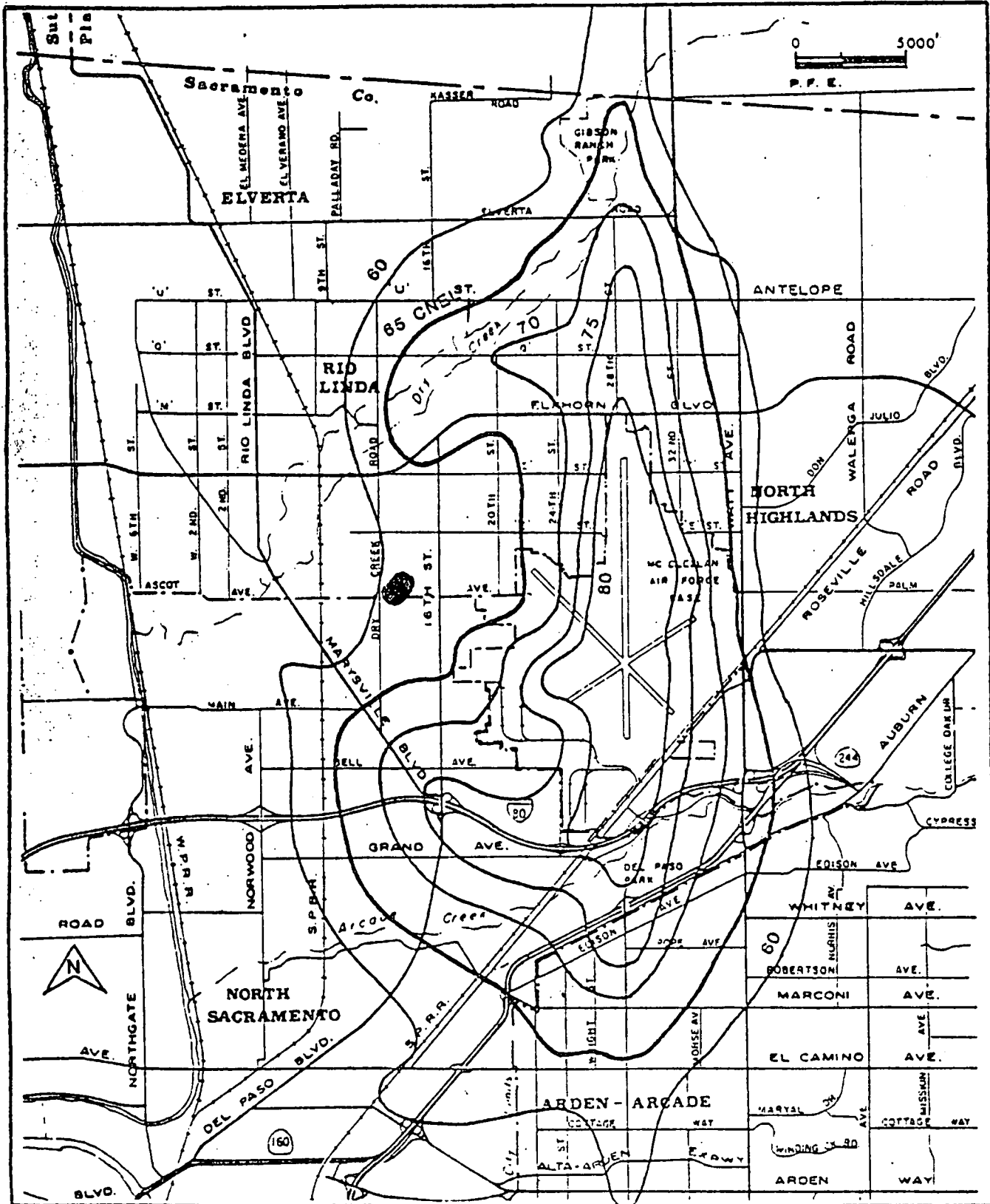
