**SUBJECT: Main Avenue/Kelton Way Traffic Signals - Project Approval and Fund  
Appropriation**

SUMMARY

Funds have been deposited with the City to cover an estimated 50% of the costs of constructing a traffic signal at the corner of Main Avenue and Kelton Way. It is recommended that the project be approved and that the funds deposited be appropriated to the project.

BACKGROUND

On February 6, 1989, a sum of \$67,500 was deposited with the City to satisfy the tentative map condition placed on the Main Avenue Business Park development (located at the northeast corner of Main Avenue and Kelton Way) to pay for one-half of the estimated costs of a traffic signal at the subject location. Additional funding will be required before the project can be constructed. The source of this additional funding is undetermined at this time. It is possible that the additional funding will come from other applicants that wish to develop property in this area. If the signal has to be constructed before other contributions are received, the City will identify an appropriate source of matching funds. Construction is expected to take place as development of the area continues.

FINANCIAL DATA

A sum of \$67,500 has been deposited in the General Fund balance sheet Account No. 2464 for the subject project. It is proposed that this amount be appropriated to the Main Avenue/Kelton Way Traffic Signal project to cover the developers half of the estimated cost.
