**SUBJECT:** Approving 1985 Fees and Charges Schedule

**SUMMARY**

This report recommends the addition on revision of standardized fees and charges for various Agency activities and services.

**BACKGROUND**

The Agency first implemented a Fees and Charges Schedule in 1983. While the large majority of the fees remained unchanged, the Schedule was revised in 1984 to reflect a few additions, deletions, and increases to the prior schedule. It is now necessary to revise the 1984 Schedule to reflect a few adjustments necessary for the 1985 year.

The attached listing (Exhibit A) shows the changes and additions to the existing 1984 Fee and Charge Schedule which has been in effect since January 24, 1984. During the 1985 year, if any new fee is proposed, or an existing fee is to be changed, staff will come before you with a resolution proposing to change the existing fee structure for that individual item.

- (3) Charge fees to cover the costs of providing services.

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
RECOMMENDATION
