SUBJECT: I-J Alley Combination Sewer Replacement from 10th Street to
11th/12th Streets (PN:XD26) - Project Approval and Bid
Advertisement

SUMMARY

Plans and specifications for this project have been prepared. Approval of the plans and specifications and authorization to advertise for bids is recommended.

BACKGROUND

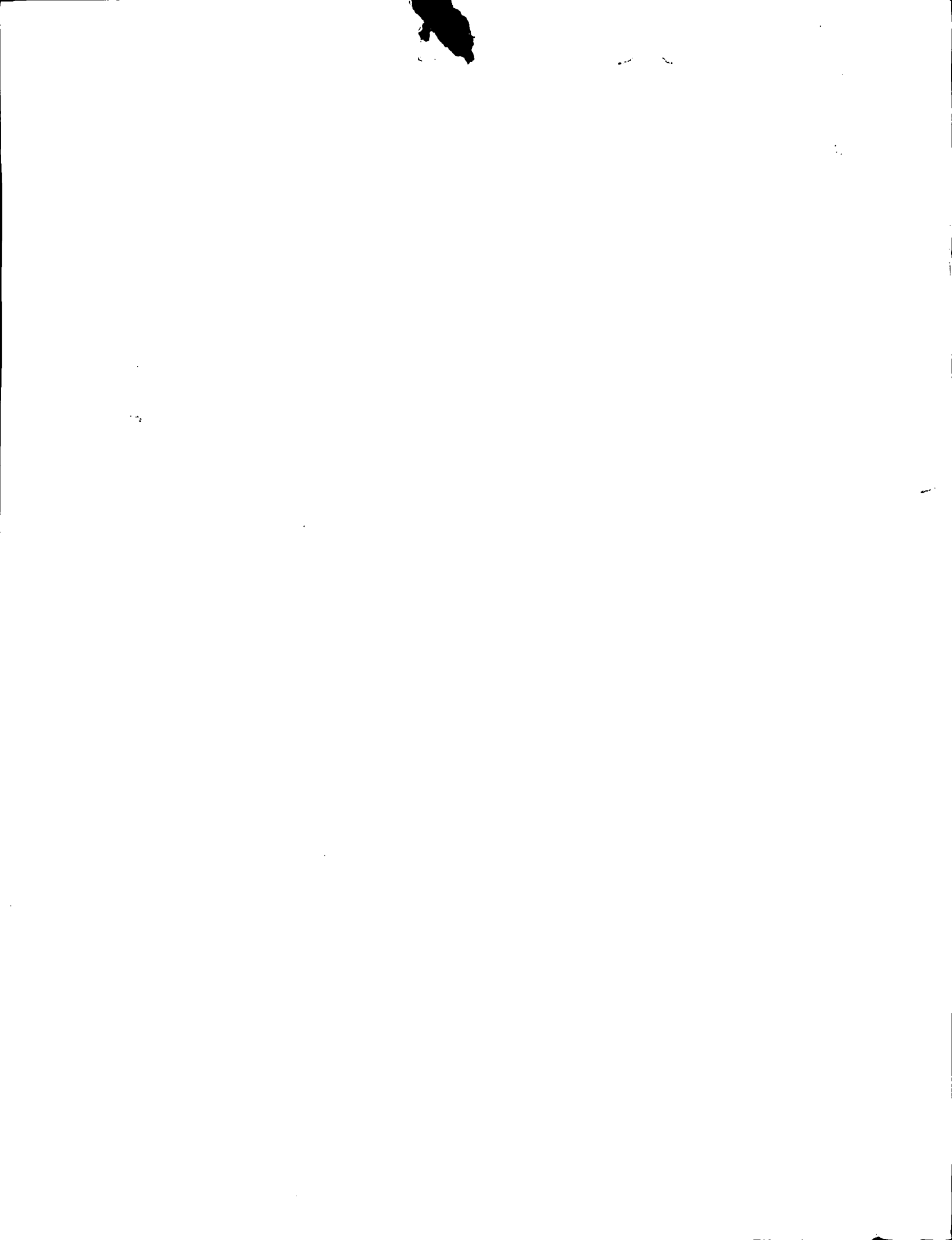
This project will remove and reconstruct the existing combination sewer line and appurtenances in the I-J Alley to 10th Street to 11th/12th Streets. This deteriorated sewer replacement is an activity preceding the construction of the Civic Center Plaza garage structure.

A Categorical Exemption for this project was filed with the County Clerk of the County of Sacramento on February 5, 1990. The engineer's estimated construction cost is \$130,000.

FINANCIAL DATA

Sufficient funds are available for this project. The estimated total project cost, including all planning, design and construction costs, is \$167,100. The current budget is \$185,700, which was approved in the Capital Improvement Program from the Sewer Fund (414). The funds available for this project amount to \$185,500, as of April 3, 1990.

A non-refundable fee of \$15.00 will be charged for each set of plans and specifications to cover reproduction costs.

POLICY CONSIDERATIONS

This action is consistent with Chapter 58, Article III, Section 58.301 of the City Code.

MBE/WBE EFFORTS

Plans and specifications will be sent to nineteen (19) plan rooms and construction services organizations for publication and use by the construction industry in Northern California. There are four (4) organizations on the distribution list that are directly involved with MBE/WBE contractors.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the City Council approve the plans and specifications for this project and authorize the City Clerk to advertise for bids to be received on May 15, 1990.

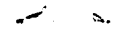
