



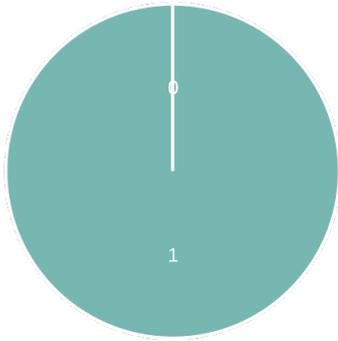

Mayor and Members of the Council,

Sacramento is facing ongoing structural deficits, and yet the response continues to be cuts to services, reliance on short-term fixes, and business as usual at City Hall. That is not leadership — that is avoidance.

If you are asking departments and frontline workers to absorb cuts, then you must do the same. The Mayor, Council, and top managers should have their salaries reduced by the same percentage as any proposed cuts. And there should be zero salary increases while this City is operating in a deficit. This must be permanently addressed by amending the City Charter to prohibit raises for elected officials and top leadership during deficit years.

What we are seeing right now is a poor example of leadership — elected officials enriching themselves while failing in their responsibility to be good stewards of public funds, all while cutting services that working-class residents depend on.

At the same time, the City must conduct a full, independent financial audit of all departments, with specific focus on homelessness spending. Billions of dollars across California have gone unaccounted for or poorly tracked. Sacramento taxpayers deserve to know exactly where their money is going and what results are being achieved. That also means real oversight — not just reports. The Mayor and Council should be conducting direct

inspections of shelters and service providers to ensure funds are not being wasted or mismanaged. And stop outsourcing core functions to expensive consultants when you already have a capable city workforce. That is wasteful and unacceptable. Sacramento residents deserve accountability, transparency, and leadership that shares in the sacrifice — not leadership that shields itself from it. The current path is unsustainable. Fix it.

Please oppose the Shelter at 3511 Arena project. Page 8 of The North Natomas plan* shows 3511 Arena designated as Parks & Rec. CA Gov't Code 37111 states that land purchased for parks in order to be used for construction of public buildings requires a four-fifths vote by the Council declaring the necessity and providing for such use. Ordinance No. 2023-00995 maybe illegal as it is giving the City Manager legislative authority equivalent to that of a 4/5 vote requirement for land use decisions via a simple majority vote.
