### SUMMARY

This project has been advertised for bids. Bids have been received and contract award is recommended.

### BACKGROUND

On August 20, 1985, the City Council approved plans and specifications for this project and bids were received and opened by the City Clerk in the Council Chambers on September 10, 1985. Bids received are as follows:

D.C.M. Construction	\$56,999.25
Mark III Engineering	\$75,934.90

The estimated completion date for the project is July 15, 1986. The engineer's estimate of construction cost was \$41,900. Although the low bid of D.C.M. Construction is 36 percent above the engineer's estimate, it is believed to be the best bid available.

### FINANCIAL

The City Council has approved \$50,000 in the Public Works budget from Sewer Funds for the project. The total amount currently available is \$49,000. It is proposed that an additional \$21,000 be appropriated from the Sewer Fund for this project.

The project to reconstruct Sump 28 has been overfunded based on the engineer's current estimate on the work to be performed. Therefore, it is proposed that \$21,000 from the Sump 28 Reconstruction project be returned to the Sewer Fund for the current project for Sump 41.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Budget and Finance Committee approve the transfer of funds and forward the report to the full City Council for passage of the resolution and contract award.
