

ORDINANCE NO. 483, FOURTH SERIES.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 35 OF ORDINANCE NO. 304; FOURTH SERIES, PASSED NOVEMBER 12th, 1926, AND ENTITLED: "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAVEL, TRAFFIC AND PARKING UPON THE STREETS AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES LAID OUT FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES AND PEDESTRIANS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; DEFINING THE TERMS USED IN THIS ORDINANCE, CREATING CERTAIN TRAFFIC DISTRICTS IN THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO; FIXING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 80, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JUNE 22nd, 1922," AND ALL ORDINANCES AMENDATORY THEREOF," AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 406, FOURTH SERIES, PASSED JANUARY 31st, 1929.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SACRAMENTO:

SECTION 1. Section 35 of Ordinance 304, Fourth Series, passed November 12th, 1926, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 35. PARKING FOR SALE.

It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle, push cart, or other device, whether moved by human power or otherwise, to park or stand the same upon any street in Traffic Districts Nos. 1, 2, 3 & 4 or upon any arterial street for the purpose of displaying it for sale or for the sale of goods or merchandise therefrom, or to park or stand such vehicle, push cart, or other device for more than fifteen(15) minutes at any one time elsewhere upon any street in the City of Sacramento from which said vehicle, push cart, or other device, merchandise or produce is being sold, except upon permit of the City Council.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 406, Fourth Series, passed January 31st, 1929, is hereby repealed.
